Rules to Raise and Exhibit a Fair Animal

- 1. Maintain a overall 2.0 GPA with no "D" or "F" to exhibit an animal at the fair.
- 2. Keep my record book up to date and it will be current before I go to attend fair.
- 3. Be enrolled in an agriculture course at WHS.
- 4. Only miss two of the Westminster FFA Monthly Chapter Meetings.
 - a. Able to make up Chapter Meetings with lunch meetings
- 5. Will participate in at least 2 (two) Westminster FFA Event or participate in 2 (two) local or sectional FFA Event.
- 6. Will attend the Westminster FFA May banquet.
- 7. If I keep my animal at the school farm I am ultimately responsible for my pen, its cleanliness and maintenance, even if I have pen mates. It is up to me to coordinate our schedules and work together in a positive attitude.
- 8. Will respect my peers who share the barn with me even if we have a difference of opinion and handle all situations in a positive, professional manner.
- 9. Will prepare my own pen with proper feeder, water and fencing, etc. or I will keep my animal at the school farm. If I keep it at the school farm, I will apply to keep it there, sign the rules sheet, fill out my farm agreement and return all the proper paperwork to Mr. Eusantos or Miss D.
- 10. Will own my hog/lamb/goat at least 60 days or rabbit/poultry at least 30 days or steer at least 120 days.
- 11. Responsible to fill out and turn in my fair entry form to the fair office.
- 12. Will wear the official FFA show uniform while showing at the fair.
- 13. If my animal does not sell at the Orange County Fair, I will take responsibility for the animal. It is my responsibility to find my own buyer for the animal. If the animal is kept at the school farm, I will remove it and I will feed and care for it until it is removed from the farm.
- 14. If my animal does not sell at the fair and I return the animal to the farm, if I do not take care of the animal properly and on a daily basis, I will give up my ownership and it can be removed and sold at any time and any amount of money owed to the school will be deducted from the total and any remaining money will go to the Westminster FFA general fund.
- 15. Will clean my pen at the school farm, before I receive my check after fair.
- 16. Required to enter and show in the Showmanship class.
- 17. Will pay all my bills after the fair. If I fail to do this I understand that I forfeit my rights to take an animal the following year. I also understand that Westminster High School will place the owed money onto my student account.
- 18. While at the fair I will not smoke/chew tobacco, consume alcohol or partake in any illegal activities.
- 19. I am responsible for my own animal the entire fair including fitting and showing.
- 20. Will refrain from using vulgar or inappropriate language while at the fair.
- 21. Agree to maintain the Westminster FFA displays by:
 - Cleaning & sweeping aisles
 - Picking up manure
 - Keeping bedding clean and neat
 - Ensuring animals do not get loose
 - Maintaining all tools, equipment, and tack in proper place
 - Feeding and watering animals
 - *If I fail to complete any feeding or maintaining of pen prior to 8am or assigned barn duty, I realize it may result in a \$20 fine per occurrence.
- 22. Will attend all announced special livestock species meetings to be eligible to show.
- 23. Understand that if I fail to abide by these rules my parents will be contacted immediately and I will suffer some or all of the following consequences:
 - Removal of my animal from auction
 - Removal of myself from fair
 - Disqualification from Westminster FFA in future years
 - Disciplinary action from WHS or HBUHSD school policies will be followed
 - 1st Violation: Verbal Warning/ Note of incident will be recorded
 - 2nd Violation: Verbal Conversation/ Letter to parent and/or guardian/ Note of incident will be recorded
 - 3rd Violation: Parent/ Student meeting with instructors/ Note of Incident will be recorded
 - 4th Violation: Livestock will be removed from school property
- 24. Agree to exhibit good sportsmanship throughout the entire fair & work with other 4-H & FFA members.
- 25. Agree to serve all barn duties and responsibilities during market week at the Orange County Fair.
- 26. Students will serve 2 volunteer hours to be provided with transportation to the fair grounds during market week.

Participating in the Orange County Fair is a **privilege** not a right as a student and FFA Member.


